The programme featured the first CBAS Annual Lecture, launching of the maiden edition of Mountain Top University Journal of Applied Sciences and Technology (MUJAST) and the send-forth/Appreciation for the immediate past Dean, Prof. Ayoola Patrick Olalusi. The Ag. Dean CBAS, Dr. E. A. Ofudje in his address, welcomed the guest lecturer, the management staff and other attendees. The Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Elijah Ayolabi in his remark, stated that the programme was timely and in

line with the vision of the University as regards research and teaching. He also applauded the efforts of the current and past Deans of CBAS, as well as the editors of the journal for making the journal publication, a reality.

CBAS annual lecture is the first of its kind in the history of our great institution. It is a forum targeted at linking the “town and the gown”. It serves as a bridge between the industry and the academia. The pioneer speaker of the annual lecture, Engr. Michael A. Shokunbi (MNSChE, MNSE, Reg. Engr), is the current head of Industrial Learning and Development of Lafarge Africa Plc. He delivered a lecture titled: **“The Prospects and Challenges of Manufacturing Industry in the Face of Unpredictable Economy”**. In his eloquently and brilliantly delivered lecture, he highlighted the importance of manufacturing industry in the development of the nation’s economy through per-

capital indicator. Speaking further, he pointed out many challenges facing the industry using the Nigerian Cement Industry as a case study. Some of the challenges pointed out include freight cost, fluctuation in dollar exchange rate, changing government policies, inadequate energy, lack of non-tariff barrier to discourage export of Nigeria cement products, among others. In

his submission on the way forward, Engr Shokunbi recommended the following for a better impact of manufacturing industry in Nigeria:

- ◆ the encouragement of production of industrial machines by indigenous companies
- ◆ improvement of education system with more emphasis on practicals and trainings
- ◆ improved access to credit
- ◆ favourable government policies
- ◆ political stability
- ◆ provision of infrastructure by the government
- ◆ collaboration between training and research institutes with the industrial sector

The presenter received a loud clapping ovation by the attendees at the end of his presentation.
